

## **DIRECTIONS TO BLUE HEAVEN:**

NOTE: The address for Blue Heaven is **NOT** found in any online map site (Yahoo maps, MapQuest etc). Do not attempt to use Blue Heaven's address to find driving directions. If you use any map guide to find driving directions, use the address "**27599 SE Eagle Fern Rd, Eagle Creek OR**" as the destination, this will get you to Eagle Fern State Park. Blue Heaven is just 2.8 miles further on the same road. CALL 503 630 2250 if you get lost and need help.

This link will give you directions from the Portland area to Eagle Fern State Park. You can always revise your destination for more accurate directions. Again, Blue Heaven is 2.8 miles past Eagle Fern State Park on the left hand side.

### **DIRECTIONS:**

**Blue Heaven is 2.8 miles past Eagle Fern Park.** The park is approximately 3 miles north of Estacada and about 21 miles East of Clackamas.

**Take Interstate 205 to Exit 12 Clackamas/Estacada  
Turn EAST onto Hwy. 212/224.**

\*Get in the right side lane after you pass McDonalds.

**Proceed 3.2 miles through Clackamas to the Hwy. 212/224 junction (Rock Creek junction), turn right onto Hwy. 224**

\*After this turn, stay on the main road (no turns)

\*You will go through Carver, then Barton, then look for the Chevron Station

**Follow signs to Estacada Proceed 10.4 miles and turn left onto Wildcat Mountain Rd. (sign reads Dover District/Eagle Fern Park.)**

\*The left hand turn is approximately one mile past the Chevron Station.

**Go 2.0 miles to Eagle Fern Park Rd.; turn right.**

The park is located 2.3 miles on the right-hand side of the road.

\*Shortly after the turn you will pass through a 4 way stop, continue straight

\*The right hand turn onto Eagle Fern Rd is marked by a blue and white directional sign reading "Blue Heaven"

**After you pass Eagle Fern Park, proceed another 2.8 miles to Blue Heaven. Blue Heaven will be on your left hand side and will be marked with a large tree stump with 'Blue Heaven' carved in it. If you reach the Fire Department building you have gone too far.**

\*There is a single large tree with a rope swing on it. The tree is the only one in the field and stands just off the left hand side of the road. If you see the tree, the driveway to Blue Heaven will be the 2nd left hand turn.
